Changes to the HSNO Act

An approved Handler Test Certificate can be revoked if the Test Certificate was obtained by fraud, misrepresentation or concealment of facts or the holder has been negligent or incompetent as a certificate holder. The Act provides a process that must be followed if a test certificate is to be revoked.

Changes to the Vertebrate Toxic Agents Transfer Notice 2004 in relation to transportation of packaged substances by road

Regulation 9 of the Hazardous Substances (Classes, 6, 8 and 9 Controls) Regulations is deemed to be complied with if a person who drives, loads and unloads a vehicle that is transporting the substance for hire or reward, or in quantities which exceed those set out in Schedule 1 of the Land Transport Rule 45001/1: Dangerous Goods 2005, has a current dangerous goods endorsement on his or her drivers licence; or, in every other case, The Land Transport Rule 45001/1: Dangerous Goods 2005 is complied with.

Changes to the Hazardous Substances (Sodium Fluoroacetate Transfer Notice) 2005
